Modular elements of different sizes with structure in double-panelled poplar and fir-wood and padding in differentiated density polyurethane foam. Base sprung with coated rubber elastic straps, padded in polyurethane foam covered in needle punched, resinated, nonwoven polyester fibre, bonded onto a polyamide velveteen backing. Backrest and armrest cushion in prewashed and sterilized goose down, stitched into separate compartments, with polyurethane foam insert.


Seat cushion in differentiated density polyurethane foam and Visco-soft insert, covered with acrylic fibre layers.
Black adjustable PVC feet.

Fabric or leather upholstery, both fully removable by zippers and Velcro fastenings.


The various elements are joined together by means of hooks. Seat depth: 68-94-120cm.


On request can be ordered a spacer, to lift the elements of further 4cm, to be screwed to the standard feet.
